

## **PARKING AT IMBAC LODGE**

Parking is provided for vehicles to remain in the National Park overnight in the allotted bays adjacent to the IMBAC lodge, this parking is provided at a competitive rate when compared to others in Smiggin Holes. Assistance is needed to ensure that the parking bays are available on the Friday and Sunday changeover of accommodation, to allow incoming & outgoing guests the opportunity to drive up to the lodge to unload or load their vehicles.

The procedure for Friday and Sunday changeover days is as follows

- Vehicles parked at the Lodge are to be removed around breakfast time and parked in the main Smiggin Holes parking area. This includes guests who have ongoing accommodation and parking for the next booking period, and those who are leaving the lodge on that day.
- Incoming guests can use the IMBAC car parking bays while unloading their vehicle, but then have to take their vehicle down to the main Smiggin Holes parking area even if they have booked overnight parking for the period of their stay at IMBAC.
- The IMBAC parking permits will be available to the incoming guests after 3:00pm which is the allotted time, after which, they can then place their vehicle in one of the allocated parking bays.
- Two wheel drive vehicles must have chains fitted, at all times while parked in the allotted bays beside the lodge, this is a requirement from National Parks and is policed by them with fines given to non-compliant vehicles.

Your assistance in complying with this procedure allows for all members and guests to be able to unload or load their vehicles at IMBAC with minimal fuss. It also complies with National Parks who can be very strict on parking outside of allotted areas even for short periods. It helps IMBAC maintain the good relationship it has with neighbouring lodges by ensuring people do not block access to their allocated parking bays.
